How are scholarships awarded?

The Scholarship Committee, made up of members of the school staff, selects the winners based on the donor's requirements and the applicant's merit. Merit is determined by marks, involvement in school activities (clubs, sports, and class offices) and citizenship (conduct, effort, and attendance).

Academic scholarship money is sent directly to the student once proof of enrollment to an acceptable college or university and the appropriate thank you letters have been received by the scholarship committee. Trade awards are awarded once the appropriate thank you letters are received.

The amount of a scholarship will never exceed the cost of its proposed use.

How does a student apply for a scholarship? Pick up an application in the Guidance Office. Fill out accurately and return before the deadline date to Mrs. deAlmeida in the Guidance Office.

Students applying for state and federal scholarships must fill out the Federal Aid Form (FAFSA).
