

# **The Alyssa E. Correia Memorial Scholarship**

## **Scholarship Overview**

**Deadline: All materials must be RECEIVED (NOT POSTMARKED)  
by April 22, 2019**

The Alyssa E. Correia Memorial Scholarship Fund helps graduating high school seniors afford undergraduate college education in their chosen fields of study. In 2019, the fund will issue five (5) \$2,500 awards. The scholarship is open to any high school senior in good standing attending college in the fall of 2019. Applicants must submit **ONLY** a completed application, **ONE** letter of recommendation from a teacher or employer, copy of high school transcript, a **BRIEF** essay (300-500 words) on paid and volunteer work and future career goals, and a statement of financial need (100-300 words). Additional materials will not be taken into consideration, and only applications that are completed in their entirety will be reviewed. **PLEASE DO NOT USE STAPLES.**

Recipients will be chosen based on financial need, paid and volunteer work history, and academic achievement. All applications must be **received by April 22, 2019**. Winners will be notified in late June 2019. Scholarship payments will be made directly to the college the student will be attending.

### **Requirements:**

- Applicants must be a high school senior in good standing and must be accepted into a college or university, enrolling in the fall semester of 2019.
- Student must demonstrate financial need, a commitment to academic achievement, and a strong work ethic.
- Completed applications and supporting materials must be **received (not postmarked)** by April 22, 2019. Do not mail by any method requiring signature.
- Applications that do not include the EFC (Estimated Family Contribution) amount as determined by the FAFSA Financial Aid Application Form will be immediately disqualified. (We do not need a copy of the FAFSA application, just the EFC number.)
