Eligibility: Must be a graduating high school senior accepted to either a college or university undergraduate program. The applicant must be a son or daughter of a registered parishioner of St. Mary's Church in Dartmouth.

Applicant must submit:

- Signed and completed application
- Official transcript from high school currently attending ***(Transcript must be in a sealed envelope and submitted with application. Please do not mail them separately. If emailing application, transcript must be emailed by guidance counselor.)***
- Minimum of three (3) letters of recommendation from non-family members. ONE must be an academic reference (teacher/guidance counselor)
- Proof of acceptance to a college or university (copy of acceptance letter).
- 1 Essay (prompt below)
- COVID Statement (prompt below)
