### **Return to Full In-Person Learning**

We are ready to welcome back our students to in-person learning this coming Monday, May 10<sup>th</sup>. There have been some changes to our regular morning process and academic schedule, to accommodate meeting local Board of Health and CDC guidelines. Please be aware of the following protocols:

- The academic schedule will **not** have our traditional rotating blocks. Rather, **it will be your Day 1 academic schedule** every day of your academic cycle through the end of the current school year.
- Students should come to school prepared with their Chromebooks fully charged, AND this is a reminder to also keep your Chromebook charger in your backpack at all times.
- There are directional arrows (signage) throughout the building to direct the flow of foot-traffic. All students, faculty and staff must adhere to the directional arrows throughout the buildings on all floors and stairways.
- We are kindly asking that students be dropped off (by car) after **7:15 a.m.**, if possible, to alleviate any crowding.
- Upon entry to the building, students will report directly to their block 1 academic classroom (if on the academic cycle) or shop (if on the shop cycle). Students are expected to be in their area before the 7:40 a.m. bell.
- Students will **not** be allowed to walk around or congregate in any area of the school grounds, before the first bell.
- Students will be assigned lunch times based on their Day 1, Block 4 academic/shop schedule.
- Student expectations during lunch: you will grab your tray and your lunch and you will sit down to eat. Seating will be on a first come, first serve basis. No students should be getting up to throw away garbage. The custodians will be circulating the lunch area. Again, students will not be allowed to congregate. Students are expected to remain seated for the duration of their lunch break.
