Important: Upon expiration, this permit must be returned by the student to the Office of the Superintendent of Schools from which it was issued, or if the Superintendent so directs, to the person authorized to supervise assignments of part-time employment. This permit is valid only while the student named hereon is a regular attendant at a public day school.

The employer must retain this permit during the hours of employment until expiration of the term of employment. If the student is assigned to two or more employers, student must transfer this permit from one employer to another whenever so directed by the Superintendent of Schools, or by a person authorized by him or her to supervise the assignment of students to part-time employment. Whoever, without authority, alters an employment permit may be punished by a fine, pursuant to G.L. c. 149, § 90 or subject to a civil citation under G.L. c. 149, §78A.
