6. Provide a short essay based on the following theme: "What does being from New Bedford mean to me?" (500+ words).
7. Provide two letters of recommendation
8. Students awarded a scholarship will be provided the money upon successful completion of their first semester. Student must provide his or her first semester transcript as well as the second semester class schedule.
