In order to be considered for a scholarship, applicants must meet all of the following requirements:

**Eligibility**

- Resident of Mattapoissett, Marion or Rochester OR member of the Mattapoissett Congregational Church
- High school senior graduating in June
- Submitted an application to or been accepted by an accredited postsecondary education program

**Application Procedures**

**Applicants must provide the following information no later than March 31, 2022:**

- Completed application
- Recommendation from guidance counselor or teacher
- High school transcript

**Award Notification and Presentation**

- Notification of scholarship awards will occur by **April 30, 2021** via email.
- Scholarship recipients will be introduced during worship on May 22, 2022, details and instructions will follow.

**Award Payment**

- Scholarship recipients must provide a copy of their **first semester transcript** and **evidence of enrollment in the second semester**, as well as the name and address to which payment should be made and the student's ID number if the payee is other than the student.
- Upon receipt of these documents, a check will be issued and mailed.
- These documents must be received in the church office by February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

- 3) High School attending
- 4) Expected date of graduation
- 5) Parent(s) name(s)—provide both if residing in same household
- 6) Sibling(s) name(s)—list those residing in same household. Indicate with an asterisk (\*) if sibling is currently attending college
- 7) List the school(s) and location(s) (city/state) to which you have applied. Indicate with an exclamation point (!) if you have been accepted. Please indicate if you have applied for OR been awarded financial aid.
- 8) If you have decided on a major field of study, please note.
- 9) List all school activities in which you have participated during high school. Include any special recognition you have received. (Indicate on a separate page, please.)
- 10) List activities within your community in which you have participated during the past four years. (Examples: church work, volunteer service) (Indicate on a separate page if necessary.)
- 11) Describe any work experience you've had during the past four years. Indicate dates of employment for each job and approximate number of hours worked each week. (Indicate on a separate page if necessary.)
