If the application is not completed in its entirety to include the essay, personal statement, and letters of recommendations, the entire application will be automatically disqualified.

Applications must be legible to be considered; therefore, it is strongly encouraged that responses be either typed or printed.

The personal statement must be **typed** and should contain no more than 300 words. **The personal statement** must include your education, career goals, and reasons for applying for this scholarship. The essay must be **typed** and should contain no more than 300 words. **The essay** must address: How your culture has impacted your life and/or your participation in your community. A resume may be included for work experience.

Interviews are required of each finalist. Your completed application with transcript, essay, personal statement and two letters of recommendations must be **received** by **April 15, 2022**.
