for
CAPE VERDEAN RECOGNITION SCHOLARSHIP
2024**

Eligibility

Eligibility is limited to graduating seniors from one of the below designated high schools who are planning to attend a regionally accredited college or university in the upcoming Fall in a program of study leading to an associate's or bachelor's degree:

New Bedford High School, Whaling City High School, Greater New Bedford Regional Vocational Technical High School, Global Learning Charter Public School, Fairhaven High School, Old Rochester Regional High School, Bishop Stang High School, and Dartmouth High School.

New Bedford residents graduating from other high schools **may** be considered.

Application Completion

*Respond to all questions and requests for information. If no information is available, reply with "N/A". An application is **incomplete** if any item has no response.*

Complete the application and be certain to include:

- Two (2) letters of recommendation, preferably from teachers or school personnel
- Copies of any college acceptance letter(s) received. *(If none has yet been received, please note that at least one will be required at time of scholarship award.)*
- High school transcripts
- Essay (250-500 words)

All application materials must be received *or postmarked* no later than **April 12, 2024.**

In planning for submission of your application by the deadline, please take into account that it will take several days for your Guidance Office to process your request for transcripts.

Scholarship awardees will be notified by mid-June and will be invited (with their parents/guardians) and expected to attend the Cape Verdean Recognition Scholarship Awards Ceremony on **June 27, 2024** to receive their scholarships.
