EXPECTED COMPENSATION WHEN WORKING IN THE FIELD:

Many factors are considered in the determination of compensation received in the beauty industry.

- Some salons rent space at a set fee.
- Some salons pay a % of service completed that ranges from 35% to 65%.
- Some salons pay an hourly wage no less than the state minimum of \$15.00 per hour. (<https://www.mass.gov/doc/massachusetts-wage-hour-laws>)
- Tips are a customary addition to regular pay, which raises the hourly rate significantly. The average salon income, including tips, appears to be about \$23.42 an hour. (<https://www.bls.gov/oes/current/oes395012.htm#st>)

PHYSICAL DEMANDS OF THE INDUSTRY

Cosmetology and Barber\Stylists can expect to be standing for the majority of the workday. This can put strain on the legs and back. It is also demanding on the arms and hands as you will be constantly moving or using them. **Manicurists and Estheticians** require constant use of the hands and arms. These professions also require sitting in a position that, without proper posture, can be a strain on the back.

All Programs: there are multiple products and chemicals used in this industry that may be considered allergens. Further, some can adversely affect the skin if proper protection measures are not followed. Chemical sensitivity to some of these products can become an issue with over-exposed to them over long periods of time. Proper precautions can prevent these sensitivities, but once they have developed there is nothing that can reverse the sensitivity.
